

NOMINATION FOR
Community Strengthening Award

Award Description

The Community Strengthening Award is designed to recognize individuals who foster welcoming, respectful, and supportive environments on campus and/or within their department. The recipient's professional and service activities should reflect the School's commitment to addressing contemporary issues related to equity, access, and community engagement. This includes creating spaces for open and constructive dialogue, encouraging a wide range of perspectives and experiences, supporting the recruitment and retention of a broad employee and/or student population, and contributing to thoughtful policy development that strengthens a culture of respect and belonging.

Who can be nominated?

Any student(s) or employee(s) in the School of Natural Resources and the Environment.

Who can nominate?

Nominations may be made by any student or employee in the School of Natural Resources and the Environment.

Information to be provided in the nominating petition:

Nominations must be assembled carefully and completely, and should include:

1. Name of nominee(s)
2. List of the nominee's contributions to creating inclusive and diverse learning/workplace environments.
3. Petition and narrative statement describing the qualities of the individual that qualify them for this award. (100-500 words.)

Selection Procedure

An Awards Committee, composed of student, faculty, and staff representatives, and appointed by the School Director, will select the award recipient based on nomination petitions submitted via [google form](#).

This award need not be presented annually.
