The Qualifying Meeting

During your first semester you and your advisor will need to coordinate a meeting with the chair of the departmental option, another faculty member in SNRE, your advisor, and yourself. The purpose of this qualifying meeting is to orient you to the program and provide initial advising regarding your first few semesters. During the meeting, the committee will review your background, research interests, and course needs. You and the qualifying committee will evaluate MS courses that could potentially transfer into your PhD program, so you must bring syllabi for the courses you would like to transfer to this meeting to the extent that this is possible. You will outline a preliminary doctoral plan of study with the courses listed semester by semester. You will also bring a one page research plan to be discussed amongst the committee and yourself.
